Declaration for Furtherance of Common Prosperity by the State of Penang, Malaysia and Kanagawa Prefecture, Japan

A Joint Statement for the Further Development of Goodwill Exchanges between the State of Penang, Malaysia and Kanagawa Prefecture, Japan was signed on October 3, 1991. Since then, close cordial and friendly ties have been established.
